Safeguarding: the road to accreditation

We appreciate the time and commitment Club officials put into ensuring your Club's Juniors are enjoying golf in a safe and positive environment. Scottish Golf is committed to supporting our affiliated clubs and organisations implement the highest standards of safeguarding across the sport and are very happy to provide clubs with support to ensure these are in place. Clubs have a duty of care not only to the children and young people in their club but also to the coaches, helpers and officials working within the club.

A change for next year

For those clubs seeking to be part of our Junior Programmes or to submit applications for funding, we will be asking that your Club has achieved the Scottish Golf SafeGolf Accreditation (or that the submission is in progress). attend training and PVG applications are submitted so we suggest this process is started now. Our Safeguarding Officer, Mary Walls is very happy to have a telephone/zoom call with your club to explain a bit more about the Accreditation Programme and take you through the requirements if that would be helpful.
