36 Hole Strokeplay Competition Gailles Links, Ayrshire

In 1892 the Edward family, who were well known Glasgow jewellers, presented this magnificent trophy for amateur competition.

It was played at various venues in the West of Scotland, but in 1927 the Edward family asked Glasgow Golf Club if they would host it annually at Gailles Links in Ayrshire.

The Club agreed and the Edward Trophy has been played there since 1928 and continues to attract a top home and international field.

Entries to the competition can be made through the Gailles Links website (www.gailleslinks.co.uk) and the entry fee is **£55.00 (lunch included)**. Entries will close on Friday 19th April and the start sheet will be published on the Gailles Links website on Monday 22nd April.
