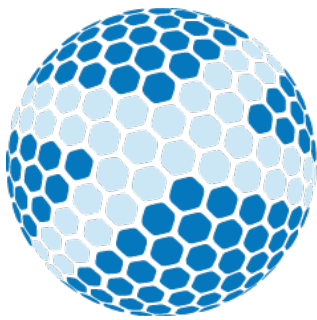

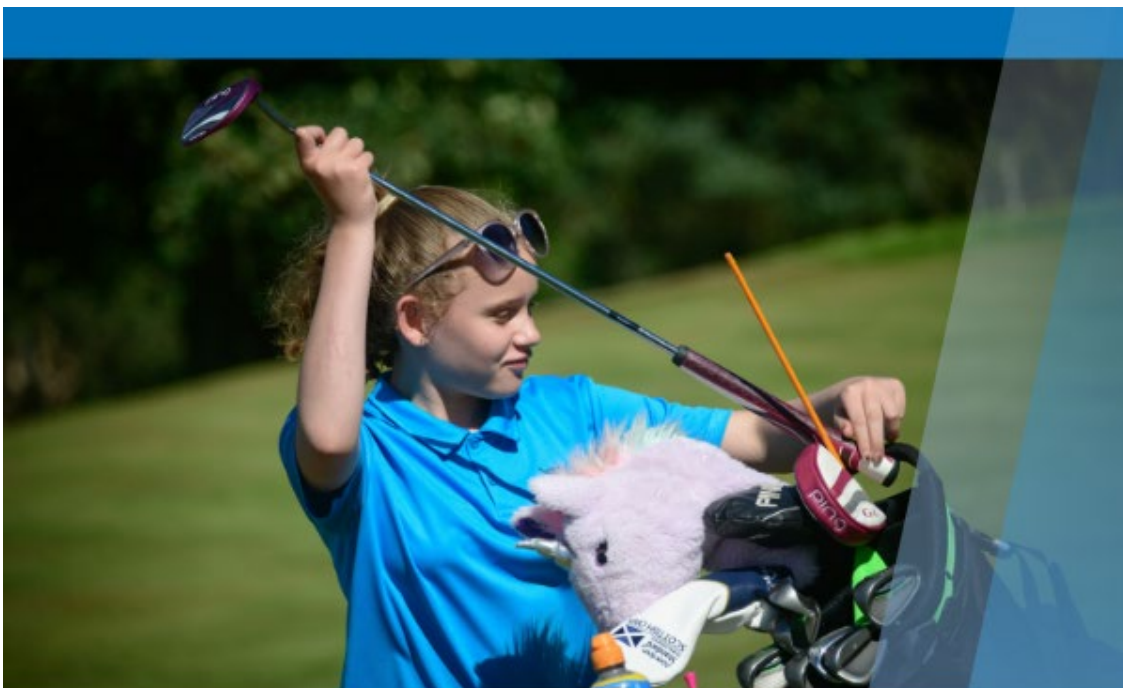

2 X FUNDS LAUNCHING 4 MARCH 2024

We have 2 funds with registrations for applications opening soon.

The Roving Pro fund enables clubs to apply for a maximum of **£600** which can be used to deliver up to 20 hours of PGA Professional coaching. Additional funding is also available for clubs identified in more remote and rural areas of the country to cover travel and/or accommodation costs of their Pro. Clubs can apply for Roving Pro funding a maximum of 3 times with a 3-year period.

Meanwhile, our **Club Hire Fund** is designed to support clubs with purchasing of new equipment for beginner golfers.

Scottish Golf will match the money raised by your Club to invest in a Club Hire Scheme up to a maximum value of **£750**.

HEART MONTH – GET YOUR CLUB INVOLVED AND HELP TO SAVE LIVES

Scottish Golf has joined forces with British Heart Foundation (BHF) to support 'Heart Month' and share an important message.

Each year over 30,000 people have an out-of-hospital cardiac arrest in the UK, with less than 1 in 10 surviving. However, giving early CPR and using a defibrillator can more than DOUBLE someone's chance of survival in some cases.

Clubs can engage with our website and social media channels over the next week to learn about access to discounted defibrillators for affiliated clubs and why registering an existing device is critically important.

Staff and golfers can also learn CPR in 15 minutes with the help of BHF's free online tool, RevivR.

LAND OWNERSHIP REGISTER

ACT NOW BEFORE THE APRIL DEADLINE

A new government register has been created to improve transparency regarding land ownership in Scotland.

Golf clubs that own or lease land may be required to register details so that this information is publicly available.

Any club required to register is legally obliged to act before 1 April 2024.

Failure to register when compelled to do so by law could incur a fine of up to £5,000.
