NEW JUNIOR GOLF PILOT PROGRAMME

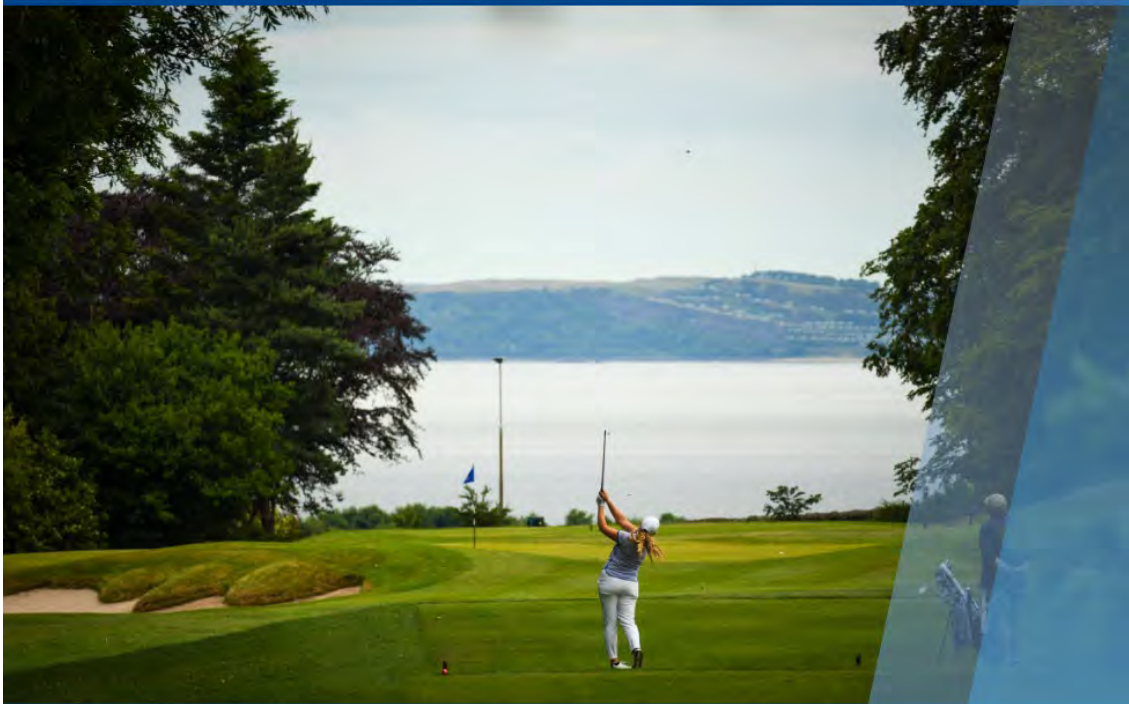
INTRODUCING GOLFNINES FOR 2024
