Growing the game through junior golf programmes



Did you know ...

Scottish Golf has a Participation team dedicated to increasing participation rates among young people and juniors, and a programme of activity ready for clubs to pick up and activate immediately!

The National Junior Framework comprises a flexible national coaching programme, funding streams and a number of key programmes that get junior golfers on the course in order to help clubs retain and build their junior sections.



The GolfSixes Leagues, Skills Challenge and Flag Championships are designed to be delivered by the golf club's own coach, but are administered and managed by our own central team.

Numbers have grown steadily in the last few years, with dramatic increases in junior girls' numbers, which we are very excited about.

Clubs work very closely with our Participation Team, who offer all the support needed to manage and run junior programmes.

Golf clubs are instrumental in embedding a love of the game into young golfers, who are then more likely to stay in the game long-term.



Scottish Golf has big plans for junior participation, including:

- Growing the number of clubs and participants in our junior programmes
- Continuing to provide funding to clubs who want to encourage juniors into the game
- Funding Roving Pro, to enable clubs with no access to a Pro to offer junior coaching
- Working in school and community settings to encourage more young people into the game

- Showcasing golf as a social, positive experience for young people
- Increasing marketing opportunities for clubs to publicise their own junior programmes
